In Russian and East European Studies
PhD Fellowships for the 2017-2018 Academic Year

The Israeli Inter-University Program in Russian and East European Studies offers a limited number of fellowships for PhD students.

The program invites PhD students from a variety of fields in the Humanities and Social Sciences (History, Literature, Religion, Sociology, Political Science, Law), who study the geographic region of Eastern and Central Europe and are registered in one of the partner universities (Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Bar-Ilan University, Haifa University, and Tel Aviv University) to submit their applications to the partnership.

The application should include the following:

- 1. Application Letter (up to 4 pages)
- 2. Research Proposal (up to 15 pages)
- 3. Short CV and publications (up to 4 pages)
- 4. A recommendation letter from the student's advisor (preferred) or one of student's professors (to be sent directly to the e-mail address below).
- 5. Detailed work-plan and timetable for the research and writing of the thesis.
- 6. Writing sample (seminar paper/ to specify the article).

Fellowship Terms and conditions -

- 1. Fellowship recipients will be awarded up to 50,000 NIS per year.
- 2. Recipients must participate in the IUAP graduate program in Russian and East European Studies.
- 3. Fellows will be requested to submit a report on the progress of their research/ writing at the end of each semester.
- 4. The scholarship will be paid in two installments at the end of each semester.

The Final deadline for the application is October 15, 2017

The Scholarship winners will be published in mid November 2017
